IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS:

WHEN USING ELECTRICAL PRODUCTS, ESPECIALLY WHEN CHILDREN ARE PRESENT, BASIC SAFETY PRECAUTIONS SHOULD ALWAYS BE FOLLOWED, INCLUDING THE FOLLOWING:

- ALWAYS unplug the appliance from the electrical outlet immediately after using and before cleaning. To disconnect, turn all controls to the 'OFF' position, then remove plug from outlet.
- NEVER leave an appliance unattended when plugged in. Unplug from the mains outlet when not in use and before putting on or taking off parts or attachments.

This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

- DO NOT reach for an appliance that has fallen in water or other liquids. Switch off at the mains and unplug it immediately. Keep dry DO NOT operate in wet or moist conditions.
- NEVER insert pins or other metallic fasteners into the appliance.
- Use this appliance for the intended use as described in this booklet. DO NOT use attachments not recommended by HoMedics.
- NEVER operate the appliance if it has a damaged cord or plug, if it is not working properly, if it has been dropped or damaged, or dropped into water. Return it to the HoMedics Service Centre for examination and repair.
- Keep cord away from heated surfaces.
- Excessive use could lead to the product's excessive heating and shorter life. Should this occur, discontinue use and allow the unit to cool before operating.
- NEVER drop or insert any object into any opening.
- DO NOT operate where aerosol (spray) products are being used or where oxygen is being administered.
- DO NOT operate under a blanket or pillow. Excessive heating can occur and cause fire, electrocution or injury to persons.
- DO NOT carry this appliance by the cord or use cord as a handle.
- DO NOT use outdoors.
- DO NOT crush. Avoid sharp folds.
- This product requires a 220-240V AC power.
- DO NOT attempt to repair the appliance. There are no user serviceable parts. For service, send to a HoMedics Service Centre. All servicing of this appliance must be performed by authorised HoMedics service personnel only.
- DO NOT sit or stand on the massage (back) part of the appliance.
- Never block the air openings of the appliance or place it on a soft surface, such as a bed or couch. Keep air openings free of lint, hair etc.
- Do not place or store appliance where it can fall or be pulled into a bath or sink. Do not place in or drop into water or other liquid.

SAFETY CAUTIONS :

PLEASE READ THIS SECTION CAREFULLY BEFORE USING THE APPLIANCE.

- If you have any concerns regarding your health, consult a doctor before using this appliance.
- Individuals with pacemakers and pregnant women should consult a doctor before using this appliance.
 Not recommended for use by Diabetics
- DO NOT use on an infant, invalid or on a sleeping or unconscious person. DO NOT use on insensitive skin or on a person with poor blood circulation.
- This appliance should NEVER be used by any individual suffering from any physical ailment that would limit the user's capacity to operate the controls or who has sensory deficiencies in the lower half of their body.

- NEVER use directly on swollen or inflamed areas or skin eruptions.
- If you feel any discomfort whilst using this appliance, discontinue use and consult your doctor.
- This is a non-professional appliance, designed for personal use and intended to provide a soothing massage to worn muscles. DO NOT use as a substitute for medical attention.
- DO NOT use before going to bed. The massage has a stimulating effect and can delay sleep.
- Do not use for longer than the recommended time.
- Care should be taken when using heated surfaces. If the product feels excessively hot, switch off at mains and contact the HoMedics Service Centre.
- Not recommended for use on wooden surfaces as the zipper may damage the wood. Caution is also recommended when using on upholstered furniture.

BATTERY CAUTIONS:

- Use only the size and type of batteries specified.
- When installing batteries, observe proper +/- polarities. Incorrect installation of battery may cause damage to the unit.
- Do not mix different types of batteries together (e.g., alkaline with carbon-zinc or old batteries with new ones).
- If the unit is not going to be used for a long period of time, remove batteries to prevent damage due to possible battery leakage.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire. Batteries may explode or leak.

MAINTENANCE:

Cleaning

Unplug the appliance and allow to cool before cleaning. Clean only with a soft, slightly damp sponge.

- Never allow water or any other liquids to come into contact with the appliance.
- Do not immerse in any liquid to clean.
- Never use abrasive cleaners, brushes, glass / furniture polish, paint thinner etc to clean.

Storage

Place the appliance in its box or in a safe, dry, cool place. Avoid contact with sharp edges or pointed objects which might cut or puncture the fabric surface. To avoid breakage, DO NOT wrap the power cord around the appliance. DO NOT hang the unit by the cord.

Plug (MODEL FC-100-GB ONLY)

If the plug on this appliance is damaged, it can be replaced with a BS 1363 plug, fitted with a 3A BS 1362 fuse. Only use a 3 amp fuse with this appliance. Care must be taken when changing the plug. If in doubt, contact a qualified electrician.

PRODUCT FEATURES:

Cushioned massaging side panels



Cushioned massaging base panels



Infrared eye

Control can be left in its cradle -

or can be picked up and held in your hand. If hand held, point red end of remote toward infrared eye in remote's cradle when pressing buttons. Note: Control will only work if pointed toward infrared eye unit up to a four foot range.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

For a relaxing foot massage:

1. Sit in a comfortable chair and place the unit in front of you so that the massage control functions can be read. Slide feet between black, upright massage panels. (Fig 1 Panels may be moving or turned off whichever is easiest for you.) Keep toes flat on surface/base during use. Placing toes in between the base and a moving panel may cause pinching.

For a relaxing calf massage:

1. Sit on the floor or a comfortable chair. If sitting on the floor, place massager in front of you on floor. If using a chair, place massager on a stable ottoman or stool at similar height to chair. (Fig 2) Massager should face direction that allows you to read massage functions on control. Slide calves between black, upright Massage Panels. (Panels may be moving or turned off - whichever is easiest for you.)

Note: Massages over 15 minutes are not recommended. To protect from over heating, unit will automatically turn off after 15 minutes. When massage is complete, remove feet or calves and turn massager off. Unplug and return cord to storage housing underneath unit. Return control to its storage cradle. See Maintenance section for storage recommendations.

Automatic shut off:

This product has been designed for convenience and safety. As a special precaution against falling asleep while using the unit, or leaving the unit on while it is still in operation, we've programmed it to automatically stop working 15 minutes after receiving your last command. Any time you change massage functions, the timer will reset. This special feature should not be considered as a substitute for OFF. Always remember to turn your unit off when not in use.

REMOTE CONTROL:



Signal Transmitter

Holding remote in hand: Area to be pointed at infrared eye on massaging unit (red light). Using remote in cradle: Automatically points to infrared eye when resting in cradle.

Off Button

Press once to deactivate any active function(s).

Kneading

Press Kneading for a high speed or low speed massage. Press Off, or the activated function, or a different speed to deactivate current massage.

- Direction

During the kneading massage, panels automatically move from front to back of foot or calf. Pressing Direction reverses massage direction to back to front. Pressing again, returns it to front to back.

Vibration

Press Vibration to activate Vibration or to add Vibration to the Kneading massage. Press Vibration again to deactivate it.

Replacing remote batteries:

Remote operates on 2 AAA batteries (included). When batteries need replacing:

Press battery release tab (Fig. 3) to remove cover.
Insert batteries 2 AAA batteries into the chamber as directed on bottom of compartment. Replace battery cover.
