IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS:

WHEN USING ELECTRICAL PRODUCTS, ESPECIALLY WHEN CHILDREN ARE PRESENT, BASIC SAFETY PRECAUTIONS SHOULD ALWAYS BE FOLLOWED, INCLUDING THE FOLLOWING:

- ALWAYS unplug the appliance from the electrical outlet immediately after using and before cleaning. To disconnect, turn all controls to the 'OFF' position, then remove plug from outlet.
- NEVER leave an appliance unattended when plugged in. Unplug from the mains outlet when not in use and before putting on or taking off parts or attachments.
- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.
- · DO NOT reach for an appliance that has fallen in water or other liquids. Switch off at the mains and unplug it immediately. Keep dry - DO NOT operate in wet or moist conditions.

- Keep cord away from heated surfaces.
- · Excessive use could lead to the product's excessive heating and shorter life. Should this occur, discontinue use and allow the unit to cool before operating.
- NEVER drop or insert any object into any opening.
- · DO NOT operate where aerosol (spray) products are being used or where oxygen is being administered.

- This product requires a 220-240V AC power.

- Never block the air openings of the appliance or place it on a soft surface, such as a bed or couch. Keep air openings free of lint, hair etc.
- · Do not place or store appliance where it can fall or be pulled into a bath or sink. Do not place in or drop into water or other liquid
- Only use attachments/accessories supplied with the unit.
- The mains plug is used as the disconnect device. The unit will remain operable unless the plug is disconnected.

BATTERY PRECAUTIONS

- Use only the size and type of batteries specified.
- When installing batteries, observe proper +/- polarities. Incorrect installation of battery may cause damage to the unit.
- · Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (ni-cad, ni-mh, etc.) batteries.
- Clean the battery contacts and also those of the device prior to battery installation.
- Remove used batteries promptly.
- When the product is being powered by mains or battery, if the unit is not going to be used for a long period of time, remove batteries to prevent damage due to possible battery leakage.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire. Batteries may explode or leak.
- · Dispose of used batteries properly in accordance with all state, province and county regulations.

Battery directive



INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

- 1. Unpack the product and check to make sure the adaptor is included (Fig 1).
- This unit is powered by a AC adaptor, which is included or by four "AA" batteries (not included). 6V === 0.3A output.
- 3. Attach the AC adaptor jack to the base of the unit and insert the cord into a 220V household outlet.
- 4. To install batteries, remove compartment cover. Insert four "AA" batteries into the compartment on the bottom according to the polarity direction indicated. Replace cover and snap into place.

Listening to Nature Sounds

- 1. Power the unit on by turning the VOLUME knob in the clockwise direction.
- 2. Press the button of the sound you wish to listen to (Fig 2). The green POWER LED will indicate the unit is on (Fig 3).
- 3. To adjust the volume, turn the VOLUME knob (Fig 3) to your desired level.
- When finished listening to the sounds you may turn them off by turning the VOLUME knob to the off position (Fig 3).

NOTE: When the unit is turned on it will always default to the last sound used.

Using the Auto-Timer

1. When the power is on and you are listening to a nature sound you may set a timer so the unit will automatically turn off.

2. Toggle through the TIMER button (Fig 3) until the corresponding LED illuminates next to the time of your choice, 15, 30 or 60 minutes. The unit will automatically shut off after the selected time and the POWER LED (Fig 3) will remain lit showing you it is still in timer mode. If you choose to listen to another timed sound press the timer button to select a desired time. Or if you choose to listen to the sounds continuously, turn the unit off and then back on.

NOTE: Do not select the TIMER button if you wish to listen to the sounds continuously.
